## WP5 Meeting on Open Science and Open Research Data

Date: 21st and 22nd March 2023

Venue: Cadiz Campus, University of Cadiz, Spain

This meeting forms part of the reSEArch-EU WP5 Task 5.4 activities. It is intended to promote the direct interaction of the project Open Science Ambassadors (OSAs) with the Open Research Data Officers (ORDOs). At this point in the project implementation, it is necessary that the OSAs gain detailed knowledge on the project deliverables in Tasks 5.1/2/3 where the ORDOs have already prepared a SEA-EU Research Data Management Policy Framework, and are preparing to synergise the partner universities to apply Open Science practices and principles. Meanwhile, the OSA programme is entering its most effective phase where the role of the OSAs will be amplified with interventions on outreach and awareness, on promotion, education and discussion with users on the benefits of OS, ORD and the value of sharing research outputs and data generally. The programme is also intended to strengthen the role of the OSAs in empowering and supporting users, and a 'Train the Trainers' session will be organised on Day 2 of the meeting to guide the OSAs in their delivery to enable and effectively provide the tools to users.

All the partner universities are expected to send their designated OSAs and ORDOs to participate physically at this meeting.

Participants from the three newly-joined SEA-EU partner universities are invited to attend through their own resources. Similarly, connections will be sought to involve CONEXUS and their parallel activities in the EU-CONEXUS RSS project.
